Dear supporters and sponsors of ChristAid International,

As we approach year's end, we often look back and remember the successes and the challenges of the prior year. As I consider the ministry of ChristAid during 2018, I am amazed at what God has done through all who are involved to bring hope and faith to the people of Uganda.

2018 began with a mission team traveling to Uganda to give of their time and energy to make ChristAid Academy safer and cleaner. The team laid concrete pavers between the two school buildings in order to reduce the dust in the dry season and eliminate the mud in the rainy season. What a difference for the children and teachers to have a safe and clean place to learn and teach.

We planned to build and open the preschool during this year as well. While our intent was to construct the building and then open the preschool, the need was so great that the preschool instruction began in a temporary structure before we even started to build the preschool. The school was opened in February with 120 children enrolled. Seeing their smiles and hearing their songs was confirmation that the preschool is a valuable asset for the education of the children of Kicuna. The preschool is now completed and the children have moved out of the temporary location and into their beautiful new building. Funds for education supplies and playground equipment were also donated providing the children with a wonderful preschool opportunity.

Many individuals have asked about the Christian education being offered at the school. While a weekly chapel service has always been a part of the schedule at the school, we are working to increase the impact we can have on the spiritual lives of the children. Discussions are being held concerning regular Bible classes for the children and materials for those classes are being considered. Not wanting to offer Christian growth opportunities only to the children, opportunities for faith development are also being planned for our staff and teachers. Already Grace meets monthly with the Grandmas for a time of praise, prayer and testimonies meaning we will be doing all we can to positively affect the spiritual lives of all those touched by the ministry of ChristAid.

We request that you please consider a year-end gift for ChristAid as we continue to meet the challenges of ministry to the people of Uganda. As we increase our ministry presence in Uganda in numerous ways, the cost of funding that ministry also increases. 


#### A WORD FROM PASTOR BRUCE.....

Recently I re-watched the movie, "Schindler's List". In it a line from the Jewish Talmud is quoted or at least paraphrased. Schindler is being encouraged by the words, "He who saves the life of one man saves the world entire." While the exact nuances of that statement may be debated, the general point is clear: saving one life is meaningful and makes a huge difference.

I am sometimes asked about the enormity of the need in Uganda and the limited number of people that we, as ChristAid, are able to help. It is true that the need will always be greater than the resources. The truth is that ChristAid along with all of the other agencies working to help the people of Uganda will not be able to eliminate the poverty, illiteracy and hopelessness. We can and do, however, make a difference and that difference extends far beyond the Ahadi Kid or Grandma that you sponsor or financial support you provide.
