CHRISTAID TAKES A GIANT LEAP TOWARDS SELF-SUSTAINABILITY

Only God could stir the hearts of ChristAid supporters to raise the money necessary for our most significant project thus far.... buying land in Fort Portal, Uganda for the purpose of building office space for our own ChristAid office **AND office space which** will be leasable to other businesses, to create sustainable income for ChristAid!!! This has been the dream of the ChristAid Board ever since there WAS a ChristAid Board, and we are thrilled that funds raised at our October 2017 Fundraiser Banquet brought in nearly enough to make this dream a reality.

A small loan has been taken out so that we have the capitol to secure the piece of land we have identified as an ideal location. It has water and power available, is along side a main access road in Fort Portal, and is of sufficient size to support our planned three story building. We have the land under firm contract and expect to close on it later this month. (February)

If you have interest in helping to eliminate this loan, please direct the funds to our ChristAid office with a note to that effect. Our Construction Team both here and in Uganda can't wait to whack down some banana trees and send in the shovels! Our heartfelt thanks to all those who have already contributed to this amazing project. We are very excited to see where this will take ChristAid in the future! Please pray for our closing to go well and for safety in the planning and building process!!

JANUARY MISSION TRIP STARTS THE YEAR OFF WITH A BANG!!







Shown above are pictures of the new MK Medical Clinic run by Dr. Moses Muhumuza (husband of our In Country Director—Grace) in Fort Portal. The clinic has a "Grandma's wing" (shown at right) where our "Grandmas for Jesus" members are able to take advantage of the health insurance that is provided to them through the extra \$5 per month that sponsors now pay for this much needed benefit. Three Grandmas were hospitalized at the time the mission team visited. Dr. Moses also serves the public in another area of the clinic and one of his nurses is a ChristAid graduate! Thank you sponsors (who now pay \$35 per month in support of their Grandma) and to Dr. Moses, who together are making life so much better for our aging Grandmas who have spent their lifetimes caring for and working the land to feed their grandchildren. Better health care is a huge blessing!





In a rare opportunity to observe Ugandan culture more closely, the mission team was invited to attend and participate in the wedding of our ChristAid school's Head Master, Frank Alimanya and his wife, Grace. The team (starting from the left in their rented wedding finery) are...Casey and Amy King, Maggie and Bruce VanDusseldorp, Director Grace and Dr. Moses, Lydia King (front), Marsha Lea Yosten, Scott and Sherri Graeser, our driver – Francis and John McGuire. The wedding was an all day event!!

The major project focus of the January mission trip was to pave the area between the ChristAid Academy school buildings to eliminate the problem of mud in the rainy season and dust in the dry season coming into the classrooms. In the pictures below, you can observe the first preparations of the area which were leveling and covering the terraced surfaces with sand.

The pavers were odd sizes and required a serious amount of sorting work before matching together well. In the third picture, it is possible to see three of the four levels paved and looking great!! The Academy teachers are thrilled with the result. Together with the recent addition of solar lights and the sanitary sewer system for the school installed on a previous mission trip.....our bush country village school is looking very big league!!

The next project to be built (for which the funds have already been raised), is a preschool, for children ages three through five. The official ground breaking was held during this trip with great fanfare. The building will be built to accommodate a minimum of 150 children. Construction will begin early this spring and will take about six months.
