#### CHRISTAID BRINGS "I-BEAM CONSTRUCTION" TO FORT PORTAL

Work is progressing well on the <u>ChristAid office building</u>, designed to bring self-sustainability to ChristAid. The first floor is nearing completion. It currently houses the ChristAid Uganda staff and a large banquet room which will soon be rentable to the public. The remaining two floors will have I-Beam construction which is a very new concept to the town of Fort Portal.

This choice will save approximately 20% on construction costs and make for a lighter building. Our ChristAid workers are scheduled to train with the I-Beam Contractor we are bringing in from Kampala, so that they can learn and be proficient at this construction themselves. These higher floors will have apartments for rent, bringing long term income to ChristAid. We welcome donations to help us finish this amazing project.



Here are two of the numerous Grandmas featured on our CA website who are in great need of sponsorship. At left, <u>Seperanza Bonabana</u> has five people to provide for (at age 69). She does this by doing gardening on her knees for other people, hoping to be paid in food. <u>Tereza Kabanyoro</u> (78) in much the same distress, has three dependents relying on her. # GRAB YOUR SHADES AND PANAMA HAT ...TAKE A SEAT IN THE CHRISTAID TOUR BUS ... AND LET'S CHECK OUT THE "GRANDMA VILLAGE" TOGETHER!!

Travelling south from Fort Portal, Uganda (population 42,500) on the road toward Kampala, you will see on the right-hand side of the road, the new "ChristAid Grandma's Village".

As we enter the Grandma's compound, you will observe the front of the first **Grandma duplex** being built. Notice the wide front veranda which features two front doors opening in opposite directions for private entrances for each Grandma. The building is three feet wider than a regular Grandma house and has two additional windows.





Now that we have driven around to the back side, you will see that there are two separate back doors, which lead to the community garden and the latrine areas. The rebar protruding above the building is ready to receive the "ring beam" which is a concrete ledge which will later stabilize the roof. The Shelters in the Storm crew are currently building the roof trusses.

Just around the corner we can take a peek at the foundation being started for the third duplex (of six) and the all- important LATRINE facilities. There are latrines planned for two corners of the complex, and they are 4-seaters!! The bus will stop for ONLY ten minutes, so please return to the bus in a timely manner. Please take special care to secure your cameras and other valuables while using the facilities, as the pit below the latrine is more than 45 feet deep. You will be responsible for any retrievals that are necessary. ©





In two short miles, we conclude our tour back at the newly occupied ChristAid Offices on your left. On the right side of the building you see work is in progress to complete the banquet facilities. If you would like to leave a tip for your tour guide, you may do so in shillings or send a check to ChristAid with the memo line "Finish that Grandma Village!!" We are fundraising for one more duplex (\$8,500), water tanks and 12 rocking chairs!! ©

#### PASTOR BRUCE - ON THE PROGRESS OF THE NEW CHRISTAID SECONDARY SCHOOL

When Grace became our Uganda Director in 2017, she talked about taking ChristAid to "the next level". The fruition of that can be seen in a number of ways, but none more clearly than in the opening of a <u>ChristAid Secondary School</u>. While our Primary School has been providing a Christian education for the children of Kicuna for over 20 years, the students have been required to attend boarding schools far outside of the area for their <u>secondary</u> education.

## That is about to change....

The ChristAid Secondary School is scheduled to open in January of 2022. The Ugandan school year begins in January, unlike in the US where it begins in September, so the next school year will see the opening of the only Secondary School in the Kicuna area. The opportunity to provide the students in the area with a secondary education is truly taking ChristAid to the next level!!



Director Grace and Headmaster, Martin Sanyu

We are pleased to announce the hiring of our Headmaster for the new Secondary school, Mr. Martin Sanyu. He has significant experience as a secondary school headmaster. Martin is married with two small children and is a committed Christian. We are blessed to have him leading the way in the preparations for opening the school.

Martin's time between now and January, will be consumed with hiring quality teachers, recruiting students, establishing curriculum, and purchasing materials. He will also be involved in setting up the science labs, computer room and library.

Cunina, our partner who built the secondary school, has also committed to provide the school with desks, chairs, and bunk beds for our boarding school dormitories. (Some students live in the immediate area and others will be coming in from Fort Portal or other near-by villages and will need boarding facilities.) We continue to work with Cunina and appreciate their contributions.

We are presently working on providing enough clean water for use at the school. We have permission to tap into a water supply that provides irrigation water to the area, but the water is not potable. We will be required to purchase a large purification system to make it clean enough for our use. If you would be interested in contributing to the cost of the purification system, we would be very appreciative. Opening a secondary school is a huge challenge, but such a great blessing towards the education of the children in the Kicuna area. Thank you for your past support, and we look forward to your continued support as we move forward with the opening of the school.
