If you would like to talk to your Ugandan family members at our May 13th Zoom session, <u>now is the time to sign up</u>! We have a limited number of spots available and we do reserve them on a first-come, first-served basis. You have the choice of coming to CHRIST COMMUNITY CHURCH at 8085 EAST HAMPDEN AVENUE, DENVER for this event, or zooming from the COMFORT OF YOUR HOME!

The zoom starts early at 7:15 AM which is afternoon in Uganda. It is a large effort to gather our Grandmas and kids together in Uganda for this event as they do not have transportation of their own. For this reason, the cut-off for reserving a time to talk is **Friday**, **April** 7^{th} , giving Grace and Kent time to build out the schedule of five-minute visits.



The sessions have been extremely well received in prior years. One of the Board members will be present at each zoom session to make introductions and answer questions. If you sponsor more than one Ugandan family member, we make every effort to schedule them together.

Please let us know as soon as possible if you would like to participate and if you will be coming to Christ Community Church (continental breakfast provided) or you prefer to zoom from home. Our Programs Manager, Kent Stannard, will help you do a practice session from home if you want to try that method. Last spring, our internet fundraiser allowed us to build new residences for the Headmasters of our Primary and Secondary schools. This was much needed as a benefit to our excellent school administrators and made it possible for us to use their former residences for expansion of the new Secondary School. THANK YOU TO ALL WHO CONTRIBUTED TO THAT AWESOME GOAL!! The house keys were recently handed over to the Headmasters and their families are settled in! God is so Good!!

Now it is time to take on a new spring fundraising project which is to help our ChristAid Preschool, Primary and Secondary schools manage their way through a food shortage crisis. Food scarcity and skyrocketing prices are devastating not only in local schools but to the entire population of Uganda.



Our goal is to raise \$52,000 to be distributed to the three schools on a greatest need basis. The enrollment of the three schools together is about 1,100 kids. You can imagine the cost of feeding them on a daily basis... without the additional stress of current shortages and economic conditions in Uganda.



"HELP WANTED"... Thoughts from Pastor Bruce - Life in Uaanda

You see the "Help Wanted" signs in many businesses these days. We are posting one also, but not for additional staff. Rather, we are claiming the phrase because we need your help to address the emergency situation in Uganda right now.



We all know that Uganda is a nation filled with desperately poor people. It is those families and individuals that ChristAid has served for nearly 30 years. As hard as it is to believe, the situation has gotten much, MUCH worse in the last year or two. It is our mission to share the blessings we have with those who are struggling to simply survive.

For example, I recently received an email informing me that one of our Ahadi kids was forced to leave the sponsorship program because his mother could no longer afford to meet his most basic needs at home. She sent him away to live with a relative, meaning his opportunity to attend school is lost. It is hard to imagine the heartache felt in this situation.

Because of the desperate situation in Uganda, parents are finding it impossible to pay the modest school fees at ChristAid Academy and Secondary School. Numerous self-pay students have been forced to drop out of school. With parents struggling to pay school fees and with dramatically increased commodity prices, the operational budgets of the schools have become a significant problem.

Balancing the budget of the secondary school was already difficult because it is in only the second year of operation, but now the primary school and preschool that have operated in the black for years are also presenting a budget with red figures!

THE WAY FORWARD!

The Board is working diligently to meet the budgetary challenges outlined above. In consultation with our Ugandan Director, Grace, and our two Headmasters, we are assessing the distribution of Ahadi Kid funds and working hard to stretch each sponsorship dollar to go as far as possible.
