The February team helped with logging operations at the heavily wooded land which ChristAid recently purchased for firewood for the school. Next, we will plant maize on the land, to fortify the porridge for our hungry school children. We thank God for His great provision for our kids and teachers.

The team also planted 83 banana trees at the Grandma Village on land purchased next door. Fencing this new land and planting other crops will allow the Village grandmas to better support themselves. The team went on safari to Murchison Falls and saw some unique and beautiful wildlife!

<u>Susan Kansime</u> just graduated from our Primary School which means she was in our amazing Seventh Grade class that scored perfect results on the National P7 Exams! (See more about this on the last page of the newsletter.) This tells us that she is a very bright student! Her sponsor for recent years is now unable to continue sponsoring her, so we are praying that we will find her a new sponsor at this time. <u>This would change her life and helps our Secondary school by enrolling another student!</u> Susan stays with her Grandmother. She loves science and wants to become a nurse to help the people of her village. Secondary school sponsorship fees for Susan are \$70 per month.

<u>Mackline Kengonzi</u> is a six-year-old little girl living in Kicuna close to the ChristAid Preschool. There are six children in the family and her job is to collect firewood and help carry water for the family's needs from a distant stream. Her father is a day laborer and finds it very difficult to bring home enough income to keep any of the children in school.

<u>Mackline loves being in class and would like to be a teacher</u> <u>someday</u>. If you would be interested in investing in Mackline and her big dreams, the sponsorship fees are \$40 per month for preschool (and primary school students). It would be a big blessing for Mackline to attend preschool, receive her uniforms, be able to play on our playground and receive a loving Christian education.





<u>Grandma Annet Kisembo</u> is 75 years old and has been responsible for supporting three of her grandchildren since the death of her daughter. She has a small piece of land that she farms for their food, but it does not produce enough to sell, so she works in other people's gardens to earn money to buy other necessities to live. It is a struggle and big challenge for her to provide.

If you would consider sponsoring Annet, she would receive cash, pastoral care from the ChristAid staff and health insurance. But <u>the biggest gifts would be giving her dignity and security</u>. The cost of sponsorship is \$40 per month for each of our "Grandmas for Jesus". Our Grandmas are the backbone of the community.

They saw amazing progress on the ChristAid Office building which is like none other in the area! Work is underway to finish the second and third floor apartments so they can be rented for income to the ministry.
